

## The 2022 Edition of the AICW Bressani Literary Prize Shortlists Announced

March 29, 2022 – The Association of Italian-Canadian Writers (AICW) is pleased to announce the shortlists for the 2022 Edition of the AICW Bressani Literary Prize, established to promote and celebrate works by Canadian authors of Italian background.

Fiction: The Afrikaner by Arianna Dagnino; The Family Way by Christopher DiRaddo; and The Undertaking of Billy Buffone by David Giuliano; First Book: The Transaction by Guglielmo D'Izzia; tiny ruins by Nicole Haldoupis; and Cracker Jacks for Misfits by Christine Ottoni; Non-Fiction: Land of Triumph and Tragedy: Voices of the Italian Fallen Workers by Paola Breda; From Sojourners to Citizens: Alberta's Italian History by Adriana A. Davies; and Driven: The Secret Lives of Drivers by Marcello Di Cintio; and Poetry: Crito di Volta: An Epic by Marc Di Saverio; Re-Origin of Species by Alessandra Naccarato; and Plastic's Republic by Giovanna Riccio.

First prize for each category is \$1000. Winners will be announced in September 2022. The Bressani Literary Prize was established by the Italian Cultural Centre in Vancouver, in 1986. Since 2020, the Prize is solely managed by the Association of Italian-Canadian Writers.
